Professor Dr. phil. Maria Besse managed the Research Center „WDW - Dictionary of the German winegrower's language“, a project of the Mainz Academy of Science and Literature, in Kaiserslautern from 2001 to 2011. Since 2012, she is working in the *Lessico Etimologico Italiano* (LEI) in Saarbrücken. As assistant professor, she acts in teaching at the Saarland University. The main focus of her studies is on older German literature, special language research, *onomastics*, genealogy, dialectology, loanword and interference research.



Dr. phil. Nathalie Besse from Riegelsberg, Saarland/Germany, born in Saarbrücken-Dudweiler, Saarland in 1988, studied Spanish and English linguistics, literatures and cultures at the Saarland University in Germany, the University of Valencia and the University of Seville in Spain, and the University of Sydney in Australia. Her doctoral thesis was about the language of Spanish online advertising.



Thomas Besse, administration graduate, born in Lebach-Dörsdorf in 1958, has worked in the Saarland Ministry of the Interior and Sports for more than 38 years. He is responsible for the organization of European and municipal elections in the Saarland among others. The main focus of his research is on genealogy (family chronicles, emigration stories to America) and regional history (baroque altars, renovations of the Schaumberg area, historical borders and border stones). He is the President of the Thalexweiler Historical Society.

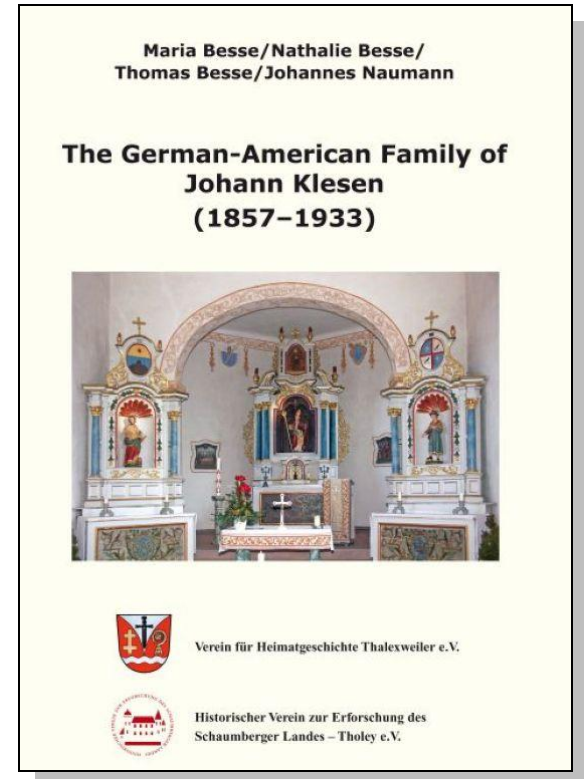
